Her Britannic Majesty's Embassy in Almaty present their compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Kazakhstan and have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan for the Promotion and Protection of Investments done at London on 23 November 1995 and, in accordance with the provisions of Article 12 thereof, to propose that the Agreement shall be extended to the Isle of Man, and the Bailiwicks of Guernsey and Jersey.

If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the Embassy have the honour to suggest that the present Note and the Ministry's reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of the Ministry's reply.

The Embassy avail themselves of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Kazakhstan the assurances of their highest consideration.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Kazakhstan present their compliments to the Embassy of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland in the Republic of Kazakhstan and have the honour to refer to the Embassy's Note No 109/99 of 6 July 1999 concerning the Agreement on Protection and Promotion of Investments between the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland signed 23 November 1995 and to agree with the amendment made by the British side:

The Ministry have the honour to confirm that the Kazakh side express their readiness to treat this Note and the Embassy's Note No 109/99 of 6.07.99 as integral parts of the Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland on Protection and Promotion of Investments signed in London on 23 November 1995 and to verify that this amendment will have come into force from 29 July 1999.

The Ministry shall avail themselves of this opportunity to renew to the Embassy the assurances of their highest consideration.
