Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Republic of Malta for the Promotion and Protection of Investments done at Valletta on 4 October 1986 and, in accordance with the provisions of Article 11 thereof, to propose that the Agreement shall be extended to the Isle of Man, and the Bailiwicks of Guernsey and Jersey.

If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Malta, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and your reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to extend to you the assurance of my highest consideration.
