The British High Commission present their compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan and have the honour to refer the Ministry to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan for the Promotion and Protection of Investments done at London on 30 November 1994 and, in accordance with the provisions of Article 12 thereof, to propose that the Agreement shall be extended to the Isle of Man, and the Bailiwicks of Guernsey and Jersey.

If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the British High Commission has the honour to suggest that the present Note and the Ministry's reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.
