His Britannic Majesty’s Embassy presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Poland and has the honour to refer to Note No. DPT.2701.31.2018/4 of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Poland dated 22 November 2018, denouncing the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Polish People’s Republic for the Promotion and Reciprocal Protection of Investments done at London on 8 December 1987 (“the Agreement”). In accordance with the second sentence of Article 13 of the Agreement, termination of the Agreement took effect on 22 November 2019.

In light of the above, the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland has the honour to propose that, notwithstanding the third sentence of Article 13 of the Agreement, the provisions of the Agreement shall cease to have effect with respect to investments made while the Agreement was in force.

If the aforementioned proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Poland, His Britannic Majesty’s Embassy has the honour to propose that this Note together with the Note of the Republic of Poland in reply, done in duplicate in the English and Polish languages, both texts being equally authentic, shall constitute the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Republic of Poland on Termination of the Continuing Legal Effects of Article 13 of the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Polish People’s Republic for the Promotion and Reciprocal Protection of Investments, done at London on 8 December 1987 (“the Agreement on Termination of the Continuing Legal Effects”).

The Agreement on Termination of the Continuing Legal Effects shall enter into force on the first day of the month following that in which the later notification between the Parties confirming that they have completed their respective internal procedures is received.

His Britannic Majesty's Embassy avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Poland the assurances of its highest consideration.

The Agreement on Termination of the Continuing Legal Effects shall enter into force on the first day of the month following that in which the later notification between the Parties confirming that they have completed their respective internal procedures is received.
